Additional information: These sandals are made for a child (11 cm in length) and can also be used decoratively. The weaver has an interesting history. She is related to the ancient Aztecs and she was raised in Mexico. She resided in Japan when she made these sandals. Their construction, particularly the sole, is clearly a Japanese technique. However, the vamp is unusual and likely reflects the weaver's roots in Mexico. The vamp was crafted as a closed cover for the front of the foot. Also, straw fibers dyed dark blue and green were braided into the vamp. This would be an unusual decoration for a purely Japanese technique and again reflects the weaver's Mexican roots.
