Additional information: These sandals are antique, owned by a family in the Philippines in the early 1900s. The sandals are Japanese in style, and there is evidence that the family traveled to Japan. The vamp is unusual, made of velvet strips with an under layer of corduroy in a crisscross style rather than the traditional thong. Another unusual feature is a layer of coiled braided hemp strips on the underside of the sole, presumably for traction.
